Dear Parent,

During the week of October 11th, your child will begin taking a MAP® Growth™ test from NWEA® on a computer or tablet. MAP Growth scores help teachers check student performance by measuring achievement and growth. Teachers use results to tailor classroom lessons and set goals for students. The assessment is given three times a year. **We will conduct our first test session remotely with the teacher proctoring students. Please look for communication from each individual teacher on your child's specific testing schedule. Due to the importance and validity of each test, your child's regular class schedule will look differently the week of October 11th through October 29th for kindergarten - 6th grade in order to test a few students at a time.**

MAP Growth tests are unique, and it adapts to your child's responses to measure your child's skill level. If your child answers a question correctly, the next question is more challenging. If they answer incorrectly, the next one is easier. These results will provide a more complete picture of what your child knows and is ready to learn—whether it is on, above, or below their grade level. Please encourage your child to do their very best. You can also help by ensuring they have a quiet space to work and reliable internet. Although teachers will be proctoring, please allow your child to work independently so that we get the most accurate results. Following the completion of all tests, you will receive a Family Report showing a summary of how your child is performing academically.
