



FACE Center-based Participation Agreement



FACE is realized through parent engagement in their children's education. Active parent engagement is what makes FACE unique among educational programs serving young children. In the center-based FACE component, parents and other adult family members participate in Parent and Child Together (PACT) Time, Parent Time, and Adult Education. They learn and practice skills that keep their families strong. They become actively involved in the classrooms and schools their children attend. They exercise their leadership by assisting the FACE program, the school, and the community to promote and celebrate family learning, Native languages and culture, and the strengths of their communities.

By enrolling in FACE center-based, we ask that you:

- Commit to ensure your child attends four days a week, but if your child must be absent or tardy, please let us know
- Commit to active and consistent parent engagement which includes PACT Time and Parent Time. You may pick one of the following:

___ Full-time adult student - Participates in PACT Time and Parent Time in FACE classrooms four days a week.

___ Part-time adult student - Participates in PACT Time and Parent Time in FACE classrooms 1-3 times a week.

We (Early Childhood Educators) agree to:

- Provide a warm and welcoming environment where you and your child feel safe, secure, and valued.
- Provide active hands-on learning using FACE Early Childhood Standards and CIRCLES: A Culturally Appropriate Preschool Curriculum for American Indian Children.

- Support you in any needs you and your family may have.
